## Summer Enrichment at SFA

*The goal of the summer enrichment course is to help the students who struggle with independent reading comprehension complete their required summer novel and accompanying packet so they can experience success when returning to school in August. Students will be guided through their summer ALEKS requirements in a staffed lab setting.

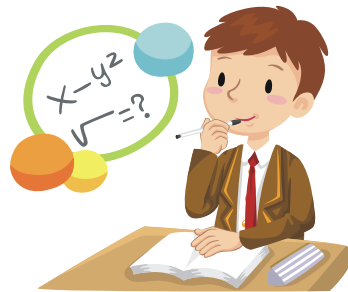
